

GIADMIN Installation

1. Check the Windows GAdmin install option from the fP Launcher.
2. The Program License Agreement will appear. Read the message and click on **Yes**, if you accept all of the terms.
3. The default installation destination folder for GAdmin will appear next. If you want to change this location, click on the **Browse** button. A **Choose Folder** file selection window will appear. Enter the path you want for the GAdmin. The path must end with **\giadmin**.

Note: If you have just installed filePro, GAdmin will look for the location of the filePro install and set the program path for you.

4. Click on **OK** and then **Next** to access the next installation screen to specify the location of your filePro data files.
5. Click on **OK** and then **Next**.
6. The **Select Components** window will appear. Be sure that **Install Java Runtime** is also checked if you have not previously installed the Java Runtime with GIservr:
7. If GAdmin has been previously installed, the install shield will ask you if you want to replace your **server's** file. If you want to replace the **server's** file you should click on the **Yes** button: If you don't want to replace the **servers** file, click on the **No** button. Click on **Yes** to replace an existing servers file.
8. When clicking on **Yes**, a screen is presented to enter the Address, Port # and Name. For Address you can enter either the IP address or machine name of the server. The initial screen will setup a default "localhost" server to be used when there is no network card installed on your system and you are running in Local Host mode. You can add any number of server entries during the GAdmin install to manage your servers. Click on **Yes** to confirm the server entry.
9. Create additional server entries by filling in the Address, Port# and Name of the server. Click on **Yes** to confirm each server entry. When you are done creating server file entries, leave all fields blank and click on **Next**.
10. When **Setup Complete** screen appears, click on **Finish** to complete the GAdmin setup. When all setup options are complete, click on **Finish** to complete the setup and exit.

Note: When upgrading, depending on the last version of filePro that has been installed, you may have to identify the location of the ~/fp and ~/filePro directories on your system. Make sure to include the correct location of these directories during the install to properly set your program and data directories paths.
